ACTIVITY NAME: Christmas Cards around Europe

APPLICATION DATE: 25th November - 18th December

ABOUT THE PROJECT:

In this project students in age 7 to 9 years old will send eachother handcrafted Christmas cards. We will use the "ordinary" post service to send them to each other. The Christmas Cards will be collected by each class and presented on a map of Europe.

AIMS:

The students will use their creative skills to produce their own Christmas Card.

They will practise english and they will also get the chance to hear different kind of european language.

They will improve their knowledge about European geography.

WORKING PROCESS:

The idea is to keep it as simple but still use the TwinSpace so new beginner "eTwinners" will get the chanse to learn how a project can be built up.

We plan to have three activites to be presented at TwinSpace:

- 1. Saying Merry Christmas in english and in your own langauge (video or audio). It would be nice to show/see how class rooms look around Europe.
- 2. Produce Christmas Cards put pictures or videos at TwinSpace during the process by making the cards.
- 3. Thank you! We will send thank you greetings by video or audio. We will show how our "European Christmas Card" maps look like.

All students will be active by producing at least one ChristmasCard with and english and a native language greeting each. The cards will be sent by ordinary post service. The students will be active by recording the greetings and also when they get the chance to listen to other childrens greetings.

EXPECTED RESULTS:

All students will know how to send Christmas greetings in english and they will also get the possibilty to learn greetings in other european languages.

They will know how to make Christmas Card.

They will get a feeling that Europe is big but we are "close" to each other in many ways.

We will use TwinSpace to show the result for each activity.
