ABOUT THE PROJECT:

This project is a place where schools from around the world exchange and show each other how students express themselves through music, singing songs in both national and English languages. The most important goal of the project is to show how important music in schools is, having an impact on the learning and life of students in every day. During the project, schools will send to the shared project board on the website, video and audio files for the songs they perform. In the last month of the project schools will send music packages by mail which will include songs recorded on a CD, photos from the course and implementation of the project, as well as musical greetings. In this way, by exchanging songs from schools from around the world, the project will promote the active use of music at school - during lessons, extracurricular activities or at school performances. The project is a place where we will be able to create a world orchestra, consisting of students, teachers and parents.

AIMS:

During the project students will learn a lot of information about the culture and customs prevailing in individual countries participating in the project. Through music expressed in many ways in the life of the school, such as during musical performances for parents or school concerts or working on lesson plans or school theater, students can learn about themselves a lot of great things, such as knowledge about the customs of the given country prevails, what is the culture there, unique values cultivated for many years, or even what is the cuisine, weather or finally what are the musical tastes in a given country. Expressing yourself through music will be a unique and fantastic idea and way for students to express themselves and show other students in the world how special people they are and what interesting school they go to in an equally interesting country. Music has been connecting people around the world for years, and the project's task is to connect students around the world.

WORKING PROCESS

Work between project partners will consist in exchanging ideas between schools on how to work at school based on broadly understood music. In this way, schools will send ideas for conducting lessons using music, scenarios of musical performances, ideas using music on school trips, and finally musical recordings of their own performances in the form of video and audio files. All these things will be posted by schools in a very easy and transparent way on a common design board that will be created on the website. At the very end of the project, schools will send musical packages that will contain tangible, real things they created during the project - CDs with recorded songs, song lyrics, musical greetings, photos from the project implementation at school, scenarios for lessons conducted using music and many more. Cooperation between teachers and students from various schools in this project is unlimited and can be shown on many levels, wherever our imagination takes us.

EXPECTED RESULTS

Project entitled "Create your own world orchestra!" is designed to show schools around the world how to use music in the lives of school, students, teachers and parents. The expected results of this project will definitely be video reports of individual schools from their musical performances. Very interesting elements of the project will also be individual plans for musical lessons or scenarios for musical events that are organized during the school year in schools. An important element for the schools participating in the project will also be work on recording CDs, which will contain songs that will be sung by students in their

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native language or English. In this way, through music, schools from various places around the world will be able to learn a lot about the culture and customs of the various countries participating in the project, and music will become a great element connecting schools, despite the fact that they are separated by a large number of kilometers.
