ABOUT THE PROJECT:

We want to create a big choir with students between the ages of 4 and 13 and to do music activities with schools located in different provinces of our country. If the pandemic continues, we aim to create a video with all choirs in it using Web2 tools.

Determining the methods of working using communication technologies the songs we have determined with the partner schools Teachers are taught the rules to be careful when running the choir Each teacher teaches the songs to his choir consisting of the number he determines. All teachers and students participate in online studies twice a month. If the pandemic is over at the end of the project, a concert is held at the Turkish Choirs festival held in Ankara on April 23, May 19 or Ankara. (concerts will be held on one of these dates if appropriate conditions occur.)
