ABOUT THE PROJECT: The project was inspired by Penelope Bagieu's comic book "Brazen - Rebel Ladies Who Rocked the World". The goal is to create our own international comic that tells the story of famous women scientists. We look forward to having our comic ready for the next International Day of Women and Girls in Science, which will take place on February 11, 2022.

AIMS: During the project, students will learn how to do research online, how to extract relevant information from a web page. They will communicate in written form through text and drawings, and they will exchange information about stories using their English skills with students from other countries, including the project, and have the opportunity to improve their communication skills and communicate in real life.

WORKING PROCESS: Students will first read excerpts from the original book, each student group will choose a scientist as their character. Students will search the internet to draw the biography of the characters, create a comic that tells their story. Products will be published online to make them available to all students involved in the project. Students from different countries will have the opportunity to exchange views on different stories.

EXPECTED RESULTS: We hope to have a comic that can be published on a public Twinspace by the end of this project.
